

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

- Operator of crude, refined product and chemical pipelines





Integrity Management Program (IMP)

- A risk-based approach to pipeline safety, required by federal regulation
- Includes rigorous testing and analysis
- Designed to identify areas that need repair or replacement



a. PRESSURE REDUCTION

Temporarily reducing a pipeline's operating pressure lowers stress on potentially damaged segments and mitigates the risk of a release while the issue is fully investigated and repaired.

b. SLEEVES

Some localized repairs are made using a steel or composite "sleeve." The sleeve fully encircles a small area of the pipe that may benefit from additional reinforcement.

c. REPLACEMENT

Sometimes it is more effective to completely replace a pipeline or a segment of pipeline. New pipe is typically laid along the existing right-of-way to limit environmental and community disruption. The older line is safely decommissioned and left in the ground once the new pipeline is operational.

Upcoming Baytown-area maintenance work

- Early- to mid-2019: pipeline maintenance in Baytown and East Harris County
- Lakewood neighborhood: Replacement of about two miles of our existing crude oil pipeline
 - Between I-10 and the northwest corner of our refinery fence

Identified through our Integrity Management Program for replacement.

About 4-6 weeks to complete

- Community outreach


Early/Mid-2019 – Fall 2019


Our commitment


- All of our pipelines will continue to be safely maintained and operated in accordance with industry standards and all local, state and federal laws and regulations.
